CITIZENSHIP AND IMMIGRATION CANADA (CIC)

APPLYING FOR A STUDY PERMIT OUTSIDE CANADA

All International Students (including USA Students) will need a **Study Permit** If the courses are for academic credit with a program of study longer than six months. A **Temporary Resident Visa** may also be required and, if there is no exemption, can be obtained at the same time as the Study Permit with no additional application form or fee.

The Salvation Army Booth University College international students should apply for university college admission at least one year before they want to commence their studies. Future students need to complete the Booth University College application for admission form and submit it to the Admissions Office. If the University College admits the applicant, the future student will receive a Letter of Acceptance from Booth University College. The Letter of Acceptance is needed in order to apply for a CIC Study Permit.

A student may order a CIC Study Permit Application (within Canada, 1-888-242-2100 or outside Canada, by contacting a Canadian embassy, high commission or consulate). The Application may also be downloaded from the web site http://www.cic.gc.ca.
